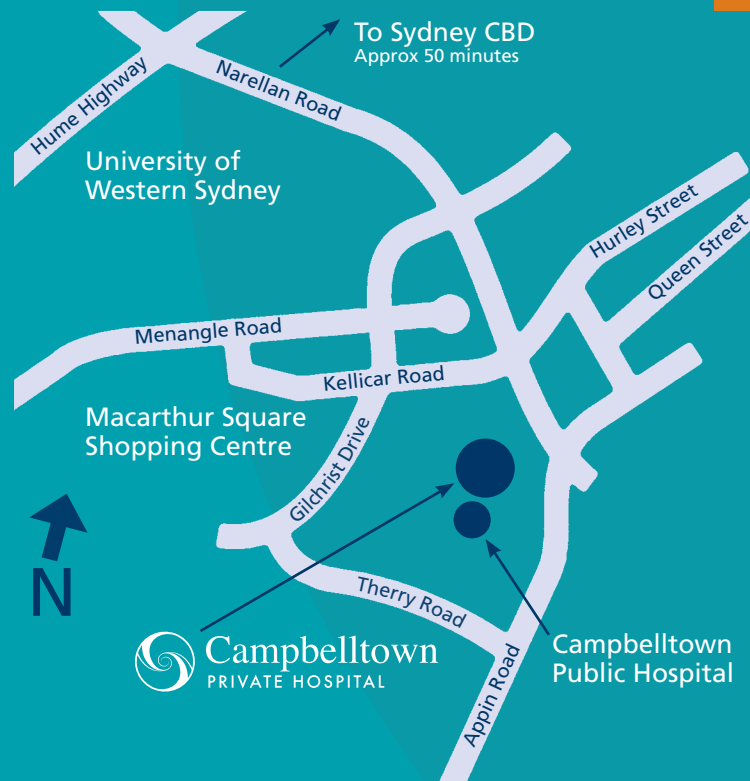

Rehabilitation

Campbelltown Private Hospital offers rehabilitation to patients following surgery, acute illness or exacerbation of a chronic condition. The Rehabilitation Centre is designed, equipped and professionally staffed to assist you work towards achieving your individualised goals.

Our Team

- Multidisciplinary team consisting of Rehabilitation Medicine Specialists, Nursing Staff, Physiotherapists, Occupational Therapists, Social Workers and Allied Health services such as Dieticians, Speech Pathologist and Psychologists as required
- 24 hour on-site medical cover

Your Rehabilitation Program Options

Rehabilitation programs are provided as inpatient and day programs. All patients are assessed prior to admission to determine treatment requirements. This will ensure that you have access to the most appropriate form of rehabilitation at each stage of your recovery.

Inpatient Rehabilitation

Suitable for patients who have a functional disability or need the support of a medical facility and nursing care. As an inpatient, physiotherapy is offered twice daily Monday to Friday, (this may include a session in the Hydrotherapy Pool) and one session on Saturday. Following surgery, the surgeon determines the length of time before a patient is able to participate in hydrotherapy. While Sunday is considered a rest day, patients are encouraged to continue a light exercise regime in the ward.

Day Therapy Program

Suitable for patients who have established rehabilitation needs without the need for 24 hour inpatient care. Patients are encouraged to access day therapy following inpatient discharge. If you are not an inpatient, you will require a referral from your General Practitioner to attend the day therapy program.

Patients on the Day Therapy Program attend the hospital twice a week for between 3 and 5 hours. Appointment days and times are arranged in consultation with the patient and continue for approximately 6 weeks.

Transport

Car parking is available in the visitors' car park, which is situated in the basement of the hospital. Regular bus services to the hospital operate from Macarthur Square, Campbelltown Station and Campbelltown Mall. The nearest train station is Macarthur Station which is approximately a 15 minute walk.

Fees

The Rehabilitation Centre is recognised and funded by most of the major Private Health Insurers. We understand that health funds can be difficult to understand, so please feel free to contact us to help you determine your level of cover. We are also able to provide services to those covered by Department of Veterans' Affairs (DVA) and Workers Compensation. For those not accessing the service through their health fund, a sliding fee is available.
