Griffith Rehabilitation Hospital has a proud record of achieving positive outcomes for patients due to the comprehensive individual rehabilitation programmes provided by our Multi-Disciplinary Team.

Members of our team include Rehabilitation Specialists, Physiotherapists, Occupational Therapists and Rehabilitation Nurses. After assessing the patient's requirements in regard to mobility, self care and other activities, the team will work with the patient to establish achievable rehabilitation goals and develop a plan of treatment specific to their needs.

A Speech Pathologist, Dietician, Psychologist and Podiatrist may also be involved if deemed necessary by the Rehabilitation Specialist.



When the time comes to leave Griffith Rehabilitation Hospital, a comprehensive discharge plan is established. This may require one of our Occupational Therapists to visit the patient's home to assess function, performance and safety, as well as determine any equipment or supports, which may be required.

A discharge summary will be forwarded to the patient's referring doctor and General Practitioner after discharge.

Admitting a patient to Griffith Rehabilitation Hospital is easy. Make a telephone call to one of our Rehabilitation Coordinators, who will:

- Liaise with the referring doctor to assess the patient
- Determine the patient's eligibility with health funds or insurance organisations
- Refer the patient to a Rehabilitation Specialist and General Practitioner unless the referring doctor has indicated a preference of specialist
- Arrange admission and all documentation

Griffith Rehabilitation Hospital is a private hospital, therefore patients must have either Private Health Insurance, DVA or Compensable Injury cover in order to be admitted. Patients must also have the potential to make functional gains, be able and willing to participate in rehabilitation, be committed to their individual programme, and contribute toward achieving the best possible outcome.

On admission, the Multi-Disciplinary Team will design an individual treatment programme for each patient. Goals will be set jointly with the patient and reviewed at weekly case conferences.

The patient is consulted and involved in all stages of their rehabilitation programme.

You are able to refer your patients to the following programmes:

Neurological

Designed to meet the needs of people with disabilities including stroke, brain injury, spinal injury, multiple sclerosis, Parkinson's disease and other neurological disorders.

Orthopaedic

Aimed at achieving the highest level of physical function following total joint replacements, spinal surgery, surgery post fractures, multi trauma, a severe fall or non surgical procedure, arthritis or soft tissue injury.

Reconditioning

For clients who are deconditioned following acute surgery, prolonged hospitalisation, complex illness or post catastrophic medical condition.

pain management

Griffith Rehabilitation Hospital has a large rehabilitation gymnasium and hydrotherapy pool and these facilities are designed to enable patients to gain maximum exercise benefits.

An occupational therapy kitchen is also available to assist patients to prepare for their return home.

Accommodation consists of a mix of private and share rooms, all with ensuite facilities, television and telephone.

Griffith Rehabilitation Hospital is located on one level with ample parking. Public transport is easily accessible with a bus stop and the Hove railway station within a few minutes walk.

Cardiac and Respiratory

To maximise physical and functional recovery following surgical and non surgical cardiac and respiratory episodes.
